

La Misión: Cabernet Sauvignon - Merlot 2004

Our *La Misión Cabernet Sauvignon and Merlot* vines grow in our vineyards in San Luis dePirque, in a light and permeable soil, finding the perfect conditions to produce the best grapes. With limited yields and sound growing techniques, we achieve the excellent grapes required for making our fine wines.

Winemaking process:

The La Misión Cabernet - Merlot is produced according to the best French winemaking style. The vinification process starts by the removal of the grapes from the stems, followed by a fermentation of the uncrushed grapes in stainless steel tanks.

Before this process, the grapes are cautiously removed from the stems, in order to remain intact, and then placed into fermenting tanks of 240 hectoliters. Parts of the grapes are separated and fermented with indigenous yeast.

Tasting note:

A deep ruby color with intense aromas of ripe red fruits, plums and berries. In the palate the wine shows soft, fruity aromas with a rich complexity, a great value.



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
